Thank you for your interest in Camp Wyoming. This packet provides information to help you in considering a visit to Camp Wyoming.

Camp Location:

Camp Wyoming is located two miles east of Wyoming on Highway 64. Refer to the enclosed map for specific directions.

What We Are:

Camp Wyoming is a year round camp and conference center supported and owned by the Presbyterian Church USA. The camp is accredited through and a member of the American Camping Association. Our 380 acres of hardwood forests, bluffs, caves and streams is a sanctuary for native wildlife. Camp Wyoming can be an intensive and exciting tool for discovering one's responsibility to others and to one's own self. Our goal is to provide mid-western hospitality to enhance your program.

Camp Facilities:

The Owl's Nest is our Conference Center for adults and families. Each of the fifteen rooms has two twin beds. The Owl's Nest has a large meeting room, fireplace, kitchen, basement recreation room, piano, outdoor deck and a fire circle. Linens are provided.

The Bird and Tree units are two very similar, yet separate units. Each unit has a central lodge with four sleeping cabins surrounding it. Each cabin holds 14 people. The lodges contain an area for meetings, kitchen facilities, and restrooms/showers. Bird Unit has an indoor fireplace. These simple but comfortable accommodations provide beds with mattresses, you provide the linens.

The Roger's Lodge is an individual lodge with capacity of 7 people. This unit has two bedrooms, kitchen facilities, a bathroom with tub and shower, a study room, and a living room. Linens are furnished.

The Deer Center has the capacity to seat up to 200 people for dining and meetings. Sound system, overhead screen/projector, and large-screen TV/VCR are available.

The Campground has 20 trailer pads, each with water and electricity. Covered Wagons, Tree Houses and Platform Tents are available for groups who want the ultimate outdoor experience. There are numerous spots for regular tent camping. All campers have access to the picnic shelter, shower house and picnic tables in the campground.

Other facilities at Camp Wyoming include outdoor volleyball courts, challenge course, Frisbee golf, outdoor chapels, labyrinth, hiking trails, monkey bridges and a swinging bridge. The swimming pool and canoeing/kayaking equipment are available in season.

Group Responsibilities:

Each group is responsible for providing program and supervision, insurance, first aid care and supplies, emergency transportation, and tidying of the buildings/areas used.

Camp Wyoming Rates

Bird & Tree Units

Total capacity per night: 56 people

Each unit has a central lodge with four sleeping cabins surrounding it. The lodges contain showers and restrooms, meeting areas, and kitchen. Bird Unit has an indoor fireplace.

Linens are not furnished.

Owl's Nest

Total capacity for unit: 30 people

This unit has everything under one roof. Each of the fifteen rooms has two twin beds. The Owl's Nest has a large meeting room, fireplace, kitchen, large recreation room, outdoor deck and fire circle. This unit is perfect for adults and families. Linens are furnished.

Roger's Lodge

Total capacity is 7 people. This unit has two bedrooms, kitchen facilities, bathroom, study room, and a living room. Linens are furnished. \$30.00 per person, per night or \$75 per night for a family. Choose to do your own cooking, or utilize the Camp's convenient food service for an additional \$15.00 per person, per night or \$30.00 per night for a family.

Campground

The campground has twenty trailer pad sites each with water and electricity; covered wagons, tree houses and platform tents. There is a picnic shelter, shower house and plenty of picnic tables. There are also numerous spots for tent camping. The shower house and water supply is available from May 1 through October 1.

Camp Wyoming Food Service and Check-Out Procedures

Food Service Options

Utilizing Camp Wyoming Food Service:

Meals are served in the Deer Center at 8:00 AM, 12:30 PM, and 5:30 PM. “Setters” should arrive fifteen minutes before the meal to arrange tables and chairs. At this time, the tableware and cold foods are ready to be set. When all tables are set the remainder of your group should be seated and a short “blessing” or moment of silence observed. This signals the kitchen staff to set the hot foods out.

Each table should have a “Table Host” to travel to the window for the hot food. Once the meal is over, the Table Host picks a helper and together they are responsible for scraping dishes into waste container, returning dishes to the window and washing tables. After the last meal, everyone should help to take down tables and stack chairs.

Preparing Your Own Meals:

Bird and Tree units are equipped with a standard home size refrigerator/freezer, stove, coffee maker, microwave, miscellaneous pots and pans, and enough table service for 56 people, while Owl’s Nest has service for 30 people. As supplies are limited you may want to bring any special cookware and utensils you feel you would need. Extra items such as hot pads, towels, paper products, dish soap, and plastic wraps/aluminum are handy items to bring along as they are not stocked in the lodge. The Owl’s Nest is the only lodge with a dishwasher. A gas BBQ grill is available if requested prior to arrival. To help keep the buildings and grounds clean, waste receptacles and recycling bins have been provided for your use.

Check-Out and Clean-Up Procedures:

The Camp Wyoming Staff take pride in presenting clean and attractive facilities for our guests. We invite you to share this responsibility with us to help keep costs down. Please report any damages you encounter.

Bird and Tree Units

Before checking out of these units, please open curtains and close windows in all cabins. Sweep the floor and pick up all the trash inside and outside of cabins and dispose in the provided receptacles. Hickory and Whippoorwill Lodges need to have all the tables and chairs put away and the floors swept. If the appliances have been used, please wipe them down. All table service should be washed and put away in their labeled locations. Inventory of kitchen supplies is taken prior to your arrival and upon your departure.

Owl’s Nest

Before checking out of the Owl’s Nest, please open curtains and close windows in all rooms. Put used linens inside the pillowcase and take downstairs to the laundry room. The bed spread should remain in the bedroom. Please empty smaller wastebaskets into the large kitchen wastebaskets. Table and chairs should be put away. If the appliances have been used, please wipe them down. All table service should be washed and put away in their labeled locations. Inventory of kitchen supplies is taken prior to your arrival and upon your departure.
